Carers, consent and confidentiality...

Can I speak to staff about someone else's health?

If you have consent from the person you are accompanying, you can be fully involved in their assessment, outcome and any follow up arrangements.

If you do not have consent from the person you are accompanying, you can raise concerns and share any information you think may be relevant. Staff will be unable to share details of patient care, but they will always listen to your views and concerns which will assist in the assessment process. **Your voice matters.**
